Pupils are united as a school community

Pupils take great pride in wearing the St Clare's uniform. It creates a sense of belonging to our school community and helps to promote equality and respect for others.

We expect pupils to be smart in their personal appearance; shoes polished, ties and buttons done up, collars down and extreme haircuts (including unusual, dyed colours) should be avoided.

- ✓ Make-up must look natural, including eyelashes.
- ✓ No false/acrylic nails to be worn and nails must be natural colour, without polish.
- ✓ In terms of jewellery, we ask that it be kept to a minimum one flat ring, one bracelet, one necklace, and only one earring is to be worn in each ear (only sleepers or studded/flat earrings).

Teachers will securely store any excess jewellery until the end of the school day but if this needs to be done repeatedly, sanctions will need to be put in place.

✓ Tattoos and body/facial piercings are not permitted.

School shoes

We are aware lots of sports' brands now make a school shoe. We are happy for pupils to wear these shoes to school but with the following provisos:

- a) The brand logo is black and not obvious;
- b) The shoe is all black leather or a pleather/leather equivalent;
- c) There are no embellishments on the shoe eg silver or gold logo toggles (as seen on some versions of the Nike school shoe range);
- d) The shoe would be suitable for a workplace and looks like a school shoe and not a trainer.
